

Restoring Community War Memorials **2008-09 Grant Recipients**

1. Avenel RSL Sub-Branch has received \$9,750 to rebuild and reinstate the marble soldier's rifle on **Avenel Community War Memorial** which was damaged by vandals.
2. Baw Baw Shire Council has received:
 - \$8,489 to restore the existing stone on the **Noojee War Memorial** and provide additional names to the plaques.
 - \$10,000 to restore the **Erica War Memorial** by replacing cracked and damaged base with granite and re do lettering.
3. Bowenvale Public Hall Reserve has received \$6,200 to restore the damaged surface of the **Bowenvale War Memorial**, and restore and replace lettering on the honour rolls.
4. Briagolong RSL Sub-Branch has received \$9,272 for **ANZAC Park** to restore the memorial and lettering, add new plaques and names including Jake Kovco.
5. Campbell's Forest & District Community Action Planning group has received \$2,300 to restore two cracked and damaged the **Campbell's Forest & District Honour Boards** at the community hall.
6. The City of Boroondara has received \$10,000 to restore the north plinth of the **Beckett Park War Memorial** which has been extensively damaged by a creeping fig.
7. The City of Port Phillip has received:
 - \$3,800 to restore the brickwork on the **St Kilda War Memorial Cenotaph** (Catani Gardens), remove graffiti and replace pointing over the steps.
 - \$7,900 to remove copper corrosion, repair pointing and clean sating from masonry on the **South African Soldiers Memorial** in South Melbourne.
8. \$9,000 for the **Port Melbourne WWI Memorial and Drinking Fountain** Melbourne to stabilise and repair damaged and eroded masonry on memorial and steps and reinstate drinking fountain.
9. The Combined Rosedale Rifle Club has received \$1,125 to restore lettering on the **Rosedale Rifle Club WW1 Honour Roll**.
10. The Commemoration Park Memorial (Hobsons Bay) has received \$1,500 to replace existing fence around **The Battle For Australia Monument Veteran's Reserve** to improve security and access to the newly renovated memorial.

11. Craigieburn Primary School has received \$1,500 to restore the deteriorated woodwork and sign writing on the **Somerton State School Honour Roll**.
12. Ellerslie and Ballangeish Soldiers Memorial Reserve (Moyne) has received \$7,580 to restore lettering on the **Ellerslie and Ballangeish Soldiers Memorial Honour Rolls** and landscape around the immediate area to improve accessibility for commemorative services.
13. Goorambat Public Hall Reserve Committee of Management has received \$1,073 to restore the gates to the **Victory Park War Memorial** to provide safe access.
14. Guildford Progress Association has received \$1,345 for the **Guildford War Memorial and Anzac Avenue** to restore metal plaques on the war memorial and replace the old timber ANZAC Avenue sign.
15. Hamilton RSL Sub-Branch has received \$4,100 to restore the **Hamilton Cenotaph** statue of "Peace" by cleaning and relettering the names on the honour roll.
16. Healesville RSL Sub-Branch has received \$8,760 to restore the **Healesville Primary School Memorial Gates** by replacing the rotten timber base.
17. The Huntly Memorial Hall Committee of Management has received \$1,000 for the **Huntly's Garden of Remembrance** to repair, seal and weatherproof the cracked weathered timber chainsaw carvings featured in the Garden.
18. Kangaroo Flat RSL has received \$7,000 to restore stonework on the **Kangaroo Flat War Memorial** and generally enhance the area.
19. Meredith Community Projects has received \$6,450 to restore stone on the **Meredith War Memorial** and generally enhance the immediate area.
20. Moreland City Council has received \$5,500 for the **Moreland War Memorial** to restore and repair granite foundations, repair lights, replace unsafe wooden steps and add inscriptions.
21. Mortlake RSL Sub-Branch has received \$182 to restore and update the **Mortlake RSL Sub-Branch Honour Boards**.
22. The National Servicemen's Association of Australia Victorian Branch has received \$1,000 to add an additional plaque at the **Mount Macedon Memorial Park**.
23. Nillumbik Shire Council has received \$4,000 for the **Kangaroo Ground Memorial Park and Tower of Remembrance** to restore plaques on the Tower of Remembrance, replace bollards to enhance security around the memorial.
24. Prahran RSL has received \$2,266 to restoring faded lettering on the **Prahran RSL WWI Community Honour Board**.
25. Rotary Club of Eaglehawk has received \$1,000 to repair cracks and damage to the **California Gully Mechanics Institute Honour Board**.

26. RSL Loch Sport has received \$4,000 to provide safe access to the immediate area around the **Loch Sport RSL and Community Memorial Park**.
27. Sale Catholic College has received \$3,500 to restore the base of the **Catholic College Sale War Memorial** and add additional names researched by the students.
28. The Shire of Moyne has received \$10,000 for the **Koroit War Memorial** to restore damaged and cracked stone on the Cenotaph and repair the plaques and honour rolls.
29. St Arnaud RSL Sub-Branch has received \$4,741 to restore five **St Arnaud RSL Sub-Branch Honour Boards** mounted on the walls in the main hall of the RSL building.
30. Stanhope RSL Sub-Branch has received \$2,500 to restore, straighten and repaint the **Stanhope Primary School Memorial Gates** and concrete pillars.
31. The Swanpool Recreation Reserve and Public Hall has received \$2,110 to repair split woodwork on the **Swanpool Hall Honour Rolls** and restore gold leaf lettering.
32. The 58th/32nd Infantry Battalion Association – City of Essendon Regiment has received \$10,000 for the **58th Battalion World War I Monument** to restore damaged original plaques and add new ones, illuminate cross with a time clock and install new flood lights.

34. The Wycheproof RSL Sub-Branch has received \$9,000 to restore lettering and plaques on the **Wycheproof RSL Sub-Branch War Memorial** and improve access and safety in the immediate area.
